Each scholarship requires its own application and you will use the same one for all scholarships. Download an application from the guidance website; fill in the name of the scholarship, then all additional information. Print. Go back and change the **name only** of the next scholarship you are applying for. (The other information is already filled in) Print...and so on.

RE: Question #7 on application: The essay you provide in this section will be the same essay for each scholarship you've applied for. The essay is a way for the benefactors to know about you.

A few scholarships require an additional essay and/or additional information. Please read the requirements for each scholarship carefully. They are set forth by the scholarship committees and if they are not included in your packet, you may be disqualified for that scholarship.

DO NOT put your name or any other identifying information anywhere on the applications or required essays unless you are asked specifically for that information. Scholarships are done anonymously and Guidance will assign each student a number.

If your final decision has not been made as to which college you will attend, list your "first choice" school on the application question 2a.

Only ONE cover sheet signed by your parents is required, regardless of the number of applications you submit. We will not accept an unsigned cover sheet.

Obtain a copy of your College Board Score Report, and include **ONE COPY** along with your cover sheet.

STAPLE each individual scholarship packet together. Put scholarships in the order in which they are listed in the packet. Place signed cover sheet on top when you turn in your applications.

You will not be eligible for any scholarships until all information listed above is submitted to Guidance. If you need assistance with printing out the application see Mrs. Cartwright or Ms. Berardi.

You must not miss the deadline. Under NO circumstances will applications be taken after the due date of March 28. Scholarship committees are counting on us to have the applications to them in time to meet and select a winner.

(We will, however, take them earlier than March 28.)

NOTE: BE NEAT! You should type whenever possible; there should be no doodling or cross-outs on your applications; watch your punctuation and spelling; and ask someone to proofread your essays.

If you have <u>any</u> questions, please see Ms. Berardi or Mrs. Cartwright <u>before</u> you attempt to do your applications. We'll be happy to guide you through the process.

Results will be kept confidential until recipients are announced during Senior Awards Night.
